BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 15, aggregated \$8,583,000,000, or 15 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 6 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,979,000,000, compared with \$9,361,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,535,000,000 the week ended January 16 of last year.
