

STATEMENT FOR THE PRESS

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BANK DEBITS

Board of Governors
of the Federal Reserve System
March 21, 1936

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended March 18, aggregated \$10,046,000,000, or 19 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 25 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$9,573,000,000, compared with \$8,033,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,610,000,000 the week ended March 20 of last year
