**BANK DEBITS**

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended April 22, aggregated \$8,745,000,000, or 4 percent above the total reported for the preceding week, which included five business days in some of the reporting cities, and 25 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,130,000,000, compared with \$7,811,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,478,000,000 the week ended April 24 of last year.
