BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended June 17, aggregated \$9,960,000,000, or 23 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 15 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$9,285,000,000, compared with \$7,488,000,000 the preceding week and \$8,065,000,000 the week ended June 19 of last year.
