BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended June 24, aggregated \$8,004,000,000, or 20 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 12 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,406,000,000, compared with \$9,285,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,635,000,000 the week ended June 26 of last year.
