BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended September 9, which included only five business days, aggregated \$6,546,000,000, or 25 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 3 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,050,000,000, compared with \$8,108,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,235,000,000 the week ended September 11 of last year.
