BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended September 30, aggregated \$9,057,000,000, or 17 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 4 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,388,000,000, compared with \$7,059,000,000 the preceding week and \$8,754,000,000 the week ended October 2 of last year.
