BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended November 11, which included only five business days in most of the reporting centers, aggregated \$8,018,000,000, or 7 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 11 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year, which also included only five business days in most of the reporting centers.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,405,000,000, compared with \$7,987,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,663,000,000 the week ended November 13 of last year.
