BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended December 23, aggregated \$12,421,000,000, or 5 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 68 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year, which included only five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$11,582,000,000, compared with \$11,050,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,859,000,000 the week ended December 25 of last year.
