BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended July 14, aggregated \$8,882,000,000, or 6 percent below the total reported for the preceding week, which contained only five business days, and 6 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,161,000,000, compared with \$8,695,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,686,000,000 the week ended July 15 of last year.
