BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended July 28, aggregated \$8,369,000,000, or 6 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 12 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,741,000,000, compared with \$8,186,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,945,000,000 the week ended July 29 of last year.
