BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended August 4, aggregated \$8,933,000,000, or 7 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 5 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,232,000,000, compared with \$7,741,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,870,000,000 the week ended August 5 of last year.
