BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended August 25, aggregated \$7,454,000,000, or 10 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 2 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,842,000,000, compared with \$7,553,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,735,000,000 the week ended August 26 of last year.
