BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended November 3, aggregated \$8,722,000,000, or 4 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 1 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,000,000,000, compared with \$8,394,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,987,000,000 the week ended November 4 of last year.
