BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 19, aggregated \$8,290,000,000, or 9 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 18 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,643,000,000, compared with \$6,998,000,000 the preceding week and \$9,437,000,000 the week ended January 20 of last year.
