BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended February 9, aggregated \$6,429,000,000, or 21 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 25 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$5,862,000,000, compared with \$7,511,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,968,000,000 the week ended February 10 of last year.
