BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended March 16, aggregated \$8,469,000,000, or 16 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 22 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,823,000,000, compared with \$6,727,000,000 the preceding week and \$10,172,000,000 the week ended March 17 of last year.
