BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended March 30, aggregated \$7,146,000,000, or 7 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 24 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,575,000,000, compared with \$7,014,000,000 the preceding week and \$8,689,000,000 the week ended March 31 of last year.
