BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended April 6, aggregated \$8,841,000,000, or 24 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 11 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,163,000,000, compared with \$6,575,000,000 the preceding week and \$9,214,000,000 the week ended April 7 of last year.
