BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended July 13, aggregated \$7,700,000,000, or 6 percent below the total reported for the preceding week, which had only five business days and 13 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,073,000,000, compared with \$7,532,000,000 the preceding week and \$8,163,000,000 the week ended July 14 of last year.
