BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended October 19, aggregated \$9,159,000,000, or 34 percent above the total reported for the preceding week, which included only five business days in most of the reporting centers, and 12 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,378,000,000, compared with \$6,299,000,000 the preceding week and \$9,551,000,000 the week ended October 20 of last year.
