## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended October 26, aggregated \$7,992,000,000, or 13 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 12 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,374,000,000, compared with \$8,378,000,000 the preceding week and \$8,397,000,000 the week ended October 27 of last year.
