BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 4, aggregated \$10,509,000,000, or 33 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 5 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year. Each of the three weeks included only five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$9,773,000,000, compared with \$7,316,000,000 the preceding week and \$9,262,000,000 the week ended January 5 of last year.
