BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended March 29, aggregated \$7,480,000,000, or 10 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 5 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,907,000,000, compared with \$7,690,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,577,000,000 the week ended March 30 of last year.
