BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended June 21, aggregated \$8,563,000,000, or 14 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 11 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,863,000,000, compared with \$6,922,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,116,000,000 the week ended June 22 of last year.
