BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended September 20, aggregated \$9,080,000,000, or 2 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 6 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,317,000,000, compared with \$8,601,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,920,000,000 the week ended September 21 of last year.
