BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended September 27, aggregated \$7,830,000,000, or 14 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 16 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,181,000,000, compared with \$8,317,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,160,000,000 the week ended September 28 of last year.
