BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended October 11, aggregated \$7,227,000,000, or 21 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 5 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year, which included only five business days in most of the reporting centers.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,547,000,000, compared with \$8,360,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,299,000,000 the week ended October 12 of last year.
