BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended November 8, aggregated \$7,517,000,000, or 21 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 13 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,845,000,000, compared with \$8,760,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,087,000,000 the week ended November 9 of last year.
