BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 24, aggregated \$7,872,000,000, or 14 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 5 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,221,000,000, compared with \$8,366,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,936,000,000 the week ended January 25 of last year.
