BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended February 14, which included only five business days in many of the reporting centers, aggregated \$6,920,000,000, or 16 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 2 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year, which also included only five business days in many of the reporting centers.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,317,000,000, compared with \$7,520,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,500,000,000 the week ended February 15 of last year.
