BANK DEBITS

Debits to deposit accounts (except interbank accounts), as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended July 3, aggregated \$10,057,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended July 3 amounted to \$109,933,000,000, or 7 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago.
