BANK DEBITS

Debits to deposit accounts (except interbank accounts), as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended September 25, aggregated \$8,097,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended September 25 amounted to \$101,113,000,000, or 1 percent below the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was a decrease of 9 percent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, while at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 4 percent.
