## BANK DEBITS

Debits to deposit accounts (except interbank accounts), as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended November 6, aggregated \$9,190,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended November 6 amounted to \$105,466,000,000, or 1 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was a decrease of 6 per cent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, while at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 5 per cent.
