BANK DEBITS

Debits to deposit accounts (except interbank accounts), as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended December 11, aggregated \$9,190,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended December 11 amounted to \$116,412,000,000, or 7 percent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of .5 percent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, and at the ^{other} reporting centers there was an increase of 8 percent.
