BANK DEBITS

Debits to deposit accounts (except interbank accounts), as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 1, aggregated \$10,608,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended January 1 amounted to \$122,213,000,000, or 8 percent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 7 percent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, and at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 8 percent.
