BANK DEBITS

Debits to deposit accounts (except interbank accounts), as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 22, aggregated \$9,331,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended January 22 amounted to \$125,664,000,000, or 9 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 6 per cent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, and at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 10 per cent.
