BANK DEBITS

Debits to deposit accounts (except interbank accounts), as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended February 26, aggregated \$8,785,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended February 26, amounted to \$124,891,000,000, or 10 percent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 7 percent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, and at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 13 percent.
