

For immediate release**BANK DEBITS—DEBITS TO DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS, EXCEPT INTERBANK ACCOUNTS**

Bank debits as reported by banks in leading centers for the week ended July 23 aggregated \$10,166,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended July 23 amounted to \$133,011,000,000, or 23 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 19 per cent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, and at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 25 per cent.
