## BANK DEBITS--DEBITS TO DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS EXCEPT INTERBANK ACCOUNTS

Bank debits as reported by banks in leading centers for the week ended December 3 aggregated \$12,078,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended December 3 amounted to \$142,373,000,000, or 24 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 19 per cent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, and at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 27 per cent.
