BANK DEBITS--DEBITS TO DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS EXCEPT INTERBANK ACCOUNTS

Bank debits as reported by banks in leading centers for the week ended January 7 aggregated \$10,329,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended January 7 amounted to \$150,756,000,000, or 21 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 14 per cent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, and at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 25 per cent.
