BANK DEBITS--DEBITS TO DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS EXCEPT INTERBANK ACCOUNTS

Bank debits as reported by banks in leading centers for the week ended January 28 aggregated \$11,019,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended January 28 amounted to \$148,877,000,000, or 19 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 11 per cent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, and at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 23 per cent.
