BANK DEBITS--DEBITS TO DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS EXCEPT INTERBANK ACCOUNTS

Bank debits as reported by banks in leading centers for the week ended February 11 aggregated \$9,492,000,000. Total debits during the 13 weeks ended February 11 amounted to \$148,956,000,000, or 20 percent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 13 per cent compared with the corresponding period a year ago, and at the other reporting centers there was an increase of 24 per cent.
