

BANK DEBITS--DEBITS TO DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS EXCEPT INTERBANK ACCOUNTS

Bank debits as reported by banks in 274 leading centers for the month of June aggregated 50,110 million dollars. During the past three months total debits for the same centers amounted to 145,078 million dollars or 10 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 3 per cent compared with the corresponding three-months period a year ago, and at the 273 other centers there was an increase of 14 per cent.
