BANK DEBITS TO DEMAND DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts, except interbank and Government accounts, as reported by banks in 345 leading centers for the month of March aggregated \$154 billion. During the past three months debits amounted to \$429 billion or 7.9 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 7.4 per cent compared with the corresponding three-months period a year ago; at 6 other centers there was an increase of 11.1 per cent; and at all other centers there was an increase of 6.8 per cent.
