

BANK DEBITS TO DEMAND DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts, except interbank and Government accounts, as reported by banks in 345 leading centers for the month of January aggregated \$163 billion. During the past three months debits amounted to \$507 billion or 9.2 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 9.6 per cent compared with the corresponding three-months period a year ago; at 6 other centers the increase was 7.4 per cent; and at 338 other centers it was 9.8 per cent.

Preliminary estimates of the annual rates of turnover of demand deposits in January are 42.0 at New York City, 25.4 at 6 other centers, and 19.5 at 338 other centers.
