BANK DEBITS TO DEMAND DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts, except interbank and Government accounts, as reported by banks in 345 leading centers for the month of April aggregated \$158 billion. During the past three months debits amounted to \$487 billion or 4.0 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was a decrease of 1.4 per cent compared with the corresponding three-months period a year ago; at 6 other centers the increase was 6.9 per cent; and at 338 other centers it was 7.9 per cent.

Preliminary estimates of the annual rates of turnover of demand deposits in April are 37.3 at New York City, 27.2 at 6 other centers, and 19.6 at 338 other centers.
