

BANK DEBITS TO DEMAND DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts, except interbank and Government accounts, as reported by banks in 344 leading centers for the month of August aggregated \$167 billion. During the past three months debits amounted to \$507 billion or 7.9 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of .6 per cent compared with the corresponding three-months period a year ago; at 6 other centers the increase was 11.0 per cent; and at 337 other centers it was 13.5 per cent.

Preliminary estimates of the annual rates of turnover of demand deposits in August are 38.2 at New York City, 25.8 at 6 other centers, and 19.9 at 337 other centers.
