BANK DEBITS TO DEMAND DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts, except interbank and Government accounts, as reported by banks in 344 leading centers for the month of April aggregated \$204 billion. During the past three months debits amounted to \$590 billion or 3.9 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago. At banks in New York City there was an increase of 13.3 per cent compared with the corresponding three-months period a year ago; at 6 other centers there was a decrease of 2.8 per cent; and at 337 other centers the decrease was 1.3 per cent.

Preliminary estimates of the annual rates of turnover of demand deposits in April are 56.6 at New York City, 30.3 at 6 other centers, and 22.5 at 337 other centers.
