



BANK DEBITS AND DEPOSIT TURNOVER

Bank debits to demand deposit accounts, except interbank and U. S. Government accounts, as reported by banks in 344 selected centers for the month of May aggregated \$296 billion. During the past three months debits amounted to \$871 billion or 12.3 per cent above the total reported for the corresponding period a year ago.

At banks in New York city there was an increase of 12.7 per cent compared with the corresponding three-months period a year ago; at 6 other centers the increase was 14.0 per cent; and at 337 other centers it was 11.0 per cent.

Seasonally adjusted debits to demand deposit accounts for 337 centers declined about 1 per cent in May to \$110.5 from the high level reached in April. The seasonally adjusted annual rate of demand deposit turnover at banks outside New York and other financial centers decreased to 28.0 in May from 28.2 in April. Over the first five months of 1962, debits and turnover for 337 centers have averaged 11 and 7 per cent, respectively, higher than in the corresponding five months of 1961.
